

Located on a working hill farm, Smithy's Bunkhouse lies in the Black Mountains within the Brecon Beacons National Park, some two miles from the historic market town of Abergavenny.

Designed to accommodate a maximum of 24 persons in two dormitories of 12 bunks, additional spaces are also available above the commonroom if required.

The bunkhouse is equipped with 3 showers, 3 toilets and 4 handbasins, other facilities include a fully equipped kitchen, a drying area (with a coin operated washer, dryer), a public telephone and a common room with a woodburning stove.

The bunkhouse is heated during the winter months by means of night storage heaters, hot water and electricity are supplied at no extra cost, some firewood is provided and extra may be purchased.

Campsite available - please ask for details.

Abergavenny boasts all the usual facilities and a 16th Century Coaching Inn is located at the top of the farm drive (roughly five minutes walk away) which serves both bar snacks and restaurant meals as well as traditional ales.

The area offers untold possibilities for outdoor activities such as walking, climbing, caving, mountain biking, canoeing, water sports, pony trekking and many more.

BOOKING PROCEDURE

Provisional Bookings can be made by telephone or letter and will be secured on payment of deposit. In instances where a cancellation is made after payment of a deposit the deposit will be refunded if either:

All beds reserved will be charged at the full rate unless 28 days notice is given.

The basic rate is £7.00 per person, per night

Group bookings &6.00 per person, per night.
